Españolé is located in the Gothic “Palacio de los Fernández de Córdoba,” in the heart of Valencia’s old town. We have carefully renovated this historic building to create a 21st-century language school that combines history with modern comfort. The building stands where the 11th-century Arab walls used to be, and parts of these walls still run through the school and classrooms, creating a unique atmosphere filled with history and mystery.

The school has 28 classrooms with interactive whiteboards, a student lounge with a reading area, a patio with fruit trees, and a rooftop garden to enjoy the beautiful Valencian weather. It is situated on one of the main streets of El Carmen, Valencia’s most famous and fascinating neighborhood, known for its narrow streets, alleys, and lively plazas.

Students usually take 20 lessons per week although we can arrange more or less lessons depending on the group needs and the time available.

Closed groups

Classes are normally organised in single-nationality groups, and the content can be adapted to meet the students' needs or for exam preparation. Group sizes typically range between **10 and 15 students**, ensuring personalized attention and an effective learning environment.

Before arriving, teachers or group organisers can inform us of the specific areas where students need improvement or which language skills are most important for them, so we can tailor the class programme accordingly. We also offer level testing to determine the best academic programme for each student based on their knowledge and interests.

Students typically take 20 lessons per week, with a schedule of 4 or 5 days and 4 to 5 classes per day, which can be arranged in either the morning or afternoon, depending on Españolé's availability. **The minimum requirement is 9 classes per programme, with at least 3 classes per day**, usually spread over 2 or 3 days. While lessons are normally held from Monday to Friday, Saturday classes can be arranged on request if necessary.



Group leaders

We know that group leaders do a great job and have a big responsibility when arranging a group programme. We want them to feel good and we are always available to help them.

We will provide free accommodation in host families, private apartments or hotels (number of free group leaders depending on the number of students). Group leaders can also attend free group lessons at the same time that their students are in class.

Host family

Group accommodation is provided with **carefully selected Spanish host families**, offering students a comfortable and supportive environment. Most students stay in **double rooms**, though **single rooms** can be arranged upon request. All rooms have **shared bathrooms**, ensuring basic amenities are available.

The **meal plan** includes options for **breakfast and dinner**, or a **full board** option that also covers lunch. Host families are attentive to students' needs and can accommodate **specific dietary requirements**, such as vegetarian, vegan, or gluten-free meals.

This arrangement gives students the opportunity to practise Spanish daily in a natural setting, while also experiencing local culture and traditions in a family atmosphere.

A cultural approach

The cultural activities and excursions are an essential part of the learning experience. Group organizers can choose from a wide range of cultural visits and group-based activities to provide a well rounded and varied trip for their students.

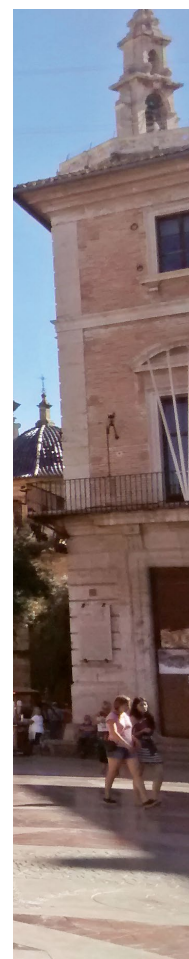
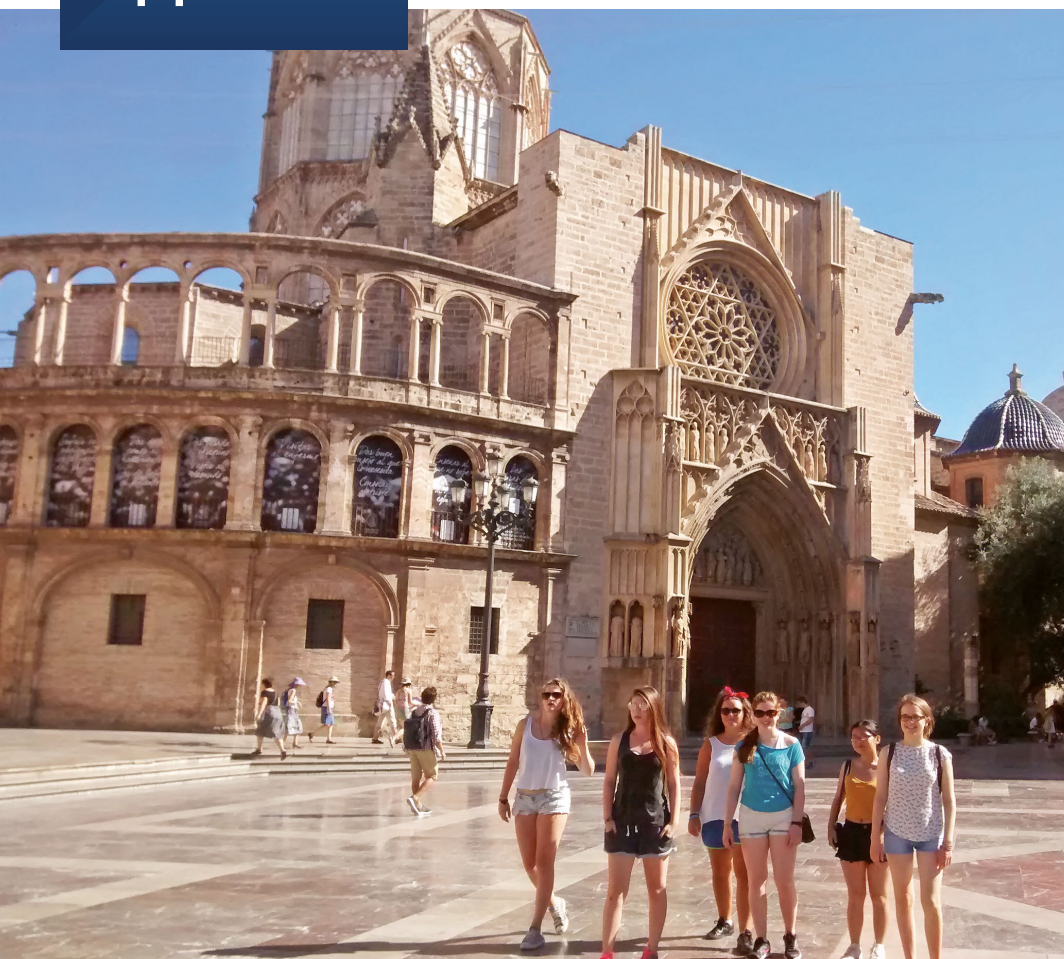
