If a group leader brings a mixed group of different ages, each student will participate in the programme designed for their age range: 13-15 or 16-19 years old. We ensure activities are appropriate for each group, allowing everyone to have a suitable and enjoyable experience.

Each participant, including the group leader, can choose their preferred type of accommodation—either in a

residence or with a host family.



We divide the teenagers into two different programmes depending on their ages, so that we can focus better on their interests and needs.



Summer camp 13-15

Perfect for our younger students (13-15 y.o), the Summer Camp is a carefully supervised programme, which still gives the students some free time after lessons and activities to spend with their new international friends.



Summer getaway 16-19

A free-style young programme aimed for students aged between 16 and 19 y.o. who want to take part in a wellstructured supervised programme, but also have free time to go out and discover the city with other students of their age.





The programme at a glance

Duration

Typically 1-2 weeks during the summer break (mid-June until mid- August).

Group Size

Maximum 15 students.

Accomodation

We offer the option of staying with welcoming host families or in a residence, depending on students' preferences.

Age Group

There are two different programmes depending on the age of the students: "Summer camp" for students between 13 y.o. and 15 y.o. and "Summer getaway" for students between 16 and 19 y.o.

Cultural Experiences

The programme includes cultural activities, excursions, visits to local attractions, museums, historical sites, dance lessons, cooking classes, workshops...

Language Learning

There are 4 Spanish language classes every day from Monday to Friday, taught by experienced teachers who will lead the programme and ensure students' learning.

Integration

Students will be in international classes with students of the same age a range and different nationality.

Our aim is to enhance students' practical Spanish skills and cultural immersion in a Spanish-speaking environment and to create a memorable and fun educational experience for them!

The school



Our beautiful school is located in the heart of Valencia's old town, in a Gothic palace, surrounded by history and culture.

We have carefully renovated this historical building to our own vision of a 21st century language school that compliments history with modernism.

The school is placed just where the 11th century Arab city walls were standing and still a big part of them have remained inside the building crossing through the school and getting inside the classrooms, creating an atmosphere of history and mystery.

Our 2100-square-metre building has 28 classrooms with interactive whiteboards, comfortable areas for students, a sunny patio with orange trees and a rooftop garden to enjoy the beautiful Valencian weather all year round.

The Españolé Teen summer programmes take place in an exclusive wing of our school to ensure all our teens are together and interacting during breaks from class in a young and international atmosphere.

The school is surrounded by history, culture, shops, cafes, historical sites and the energetic Spanish city life.



The school's friendly atmosphere is perfect to use the new language skills to make friends.








Quality assurance

We are proud to be part of International House World Organization (IHWO) which has over 60 years' experience in improving quality in language teaching.

We are also accredited by the Instituto Cervantes and members of the prestigious organisation of language schools IALC.



There are four Spanish lessons every day, they can be in the morning or following a zig zag schedule (some days in the morning with activities taking place in the afternoon and some days activities taking place in the morning and lessons in the afternoon).

During the course students become immersed in Spanish language and culture, learn how people use the language in real life, how they speak to each other in the street and how they socialise. Students develop skills that they can immediately practise outside the classroom.

Our Spanish lessons focus on communication skills, although grammar and vocabulary are also important.

* Students from both programmes might share some lessons.

Levels

The courses are divided up into 6 different levels: from beginner to advanced based on the Cervantes Institute programme under the directives of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

Students in the group don't need to have the same level. No matter what the level of the student is, we will always find a class which will suit each one of them

The Spanish classes

All classes are given in Spanish. In general the number of students per class is between 6 and 12 and each lesson lasts for 50 minutes.

Since the groups are small in number, the teacher is able to deal with the specific needs of each student on a more personal basis.

The classes are based on tasks and planned depending on the students' needs and styles of learning.

Students will use a textbook in class, together with supplemental material such as newspaper/press articles, adverts, audio-visual materials, etc.

Our teachers

We have a dynamic team of teachers who love teaching Spanish. They're all university graduates and have many years of experience specialising in teaching foreign students.

They use modern materials and methods to ensure that lessons are interesting and entertaining.

Accommodation

We offer our teens the choice to be totally integrated into the Valencian life by staying with a host family or share their experience with other international young students by living in a student residence.















Host family

Our host families are carefully chosen to provide the utmost comfort and care for our teenagers. Most of our host families have been with us for years taking in our students all year round.

Students are accommodated in double rooms including full board, and we place them together with another teen of a different mother tongue.

Lunch can be packed or hot. Students can choose whether they would like to go home for lunch or take it packed to school.

Weekly laundry and cleaning are included.

The average journey to school for our students is 25 minutes (walking or by public transport, depending on their location).

Residence

We offer accommodation in a brand-new residence located just a 12-minute walk from the school. providing students with easy access to classes and the best of the city.

The residence features bright, wellfurnished double rooms with private bathrooms, as well as some individual rooms.

Common areas include study rooms, lounges, a gym, and a cafeteria serving breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Weekly cleaning and changes of sheets and towels are also provided.

Our dedicated staff is available 24/7 to ensure students feel safe. comfortable, and well-supported throughout their stay.



Do the students in the group have to choose the same type of FAQ accommodation?

No, each student can choose the type of accommodation they prefer. They can opt for either a residence or a host family, depending on their preferences. Even within the same group, some students can stay in the residence while others choose a host family. The group leader also has the option to choose the accommodation that suits them best, either in the residence or with a host family.











Activities and excursions

Our programme of activities and excursions will help our students discover the Spanish culture, the friendly attitude of the locals and the festive atmosphere of our city.

Every day there will be activities which include cultural visits, sports competitions, barbecues, dancing lessons, afternoons at the beach or shopping.

On Saturdays we run full-day excursions, while on Sundays students are free to spend the day with their hosts or to meet friends and join the school activity in the evening.

Experienced teachers and coordinators take care of our students and accompany them during all the cultural activities, visits and excursions included in the programme.

Arrival and departure

Arrivals are normally on Sundays and departures on Saturdays (extra nights might be possible at extra cost).

We can pick up the students at the airport and take them to the host family or residence with an extra cost.

Also on departure students can be picked up at their accommodation and driven to the departure terminal of the airport.



Supervision and security

Every outing is supervised by our school staff who watch out for the wellbeing and safety of our students. Specialist activities such as sailing, paragliding, etc, are always supervised by professional instructors.

Students are expected to attend lessons and activities as scheduled, and have to respect the programme curfew that is established depending on age.

Curfews



For 13-15 y.o.

Sunday to Thursday: Students have to be back for dinner, and are not allowed to go out later. Dinner is normally between 21:00 and 21:30.

Friday and Saturday: Return to their accommodation by 23:00.



For 16-19 y.o.

Sunday to Thursday: Return to their accommodation by 00:00.

Friday and Saturday: Return to their accommodation by 01:00.









The first day

On Monday morning host families accompany the teens to school and show them the way back home, either walking or by public transport.

Students living in residence will be accompanied on Monday morning by our school staff.

Students will then take a level test so that they can be placed in the class of the corresponding level.

After the test, they will attend a Welcome meeting where they will receive useful information and get to know other new students and the staff of the school.

Once the tests have been reviewed, every student is placed in a group and the classes can begin.

Complete beginners of Spanish don't have to take the level test but will participate in the Welcome meeting.

** It's possible to book the "extra supervision service" if parents want the host family or our staff to accompany the children every day to school and pick them up in the evening after the activities.



Start dates

All levels can start every Monday from 16th June to 11th August.

The programme finishes on the 16th August.

Arrivals are normally the Sunday before. Arriving on Saturday or leaving on Sunday is also possible adding an "extra night" fee.

Group leaders

We know that group leaders do a great job and have a big responsibility when arranging a group programme. We want them to feel good and we are always available to help them.

We will provide free accommodation in host family or residence.

It's crucial for group leaders to understand that their students will be participating in a preestablished international programme, with no flexibility for making changes. If a group leader prefers a programme tailored specifically for their group's needs, they should consider opting for the 'Closed Groups Programme' instead of this one. We want to ensure a smooth experience for everyone, and this helps us maintain the integrity of the international programme.

Our dedicated team of teachers and monitors will supervise and support students during their class and activity hours. We kindly request that group leaders refrain from involvement during these times, as it is essential for the students' group dynamics and learning experience. Group leaders are responsible for the students outside of these scheduled hours, ensuring they adhere to the programme rules and curfew. Their support in this regard is greatly appreciated."
