How the University Pathway works

STEP
1

Improve your Spanish

Before starting university preparation, students must reach a B2 level of Spanish.

This is achieved through our Intensive Spanish courses (20 lessons per week), which prepare students for both academic studies and everyday life in Spain.

STEP
2

Prepare for the university entrance exam

Once students have a good command of Spanish, they move on to the academic phase. Depending on their academic background, some students may be able to access university directly without taking the PAU/PCE exams.

When the entrance exam is required, students prepare the PAU/PCE, Spain's official university access exam for degrees with higher entry requirements. They choose 2 to 6 subjects (at least 4 are recommended), with guided subject

selection based on the chosen degree and university.

Preparation is fully personalised. Students complete an initial academic assessment and follow an individual study plan with a personal tutor, continuous evaluation and regular feedback. The course runs until May, preparing students for the June exam session, with an additional session available in September.

3**

Get your qualification and select your university

The final access mark combines 60% of upper-secondary school grades and 40% of the university entrance exam (PAU). The maximum score is 14 points, with 5 points considered a pass.

Each degree has its own cut-off mark (usually between 5 and 13.8), which changes every year depending on demand. With the final mark, students can apply to up to five universities.

4**

Welcome to the Spanish university life!

Admission results are published in summer. Once accepted, students confirm their place and begin their university studies in Spain.

University admission depends on each student's academic background. Some students may access university directly once their diploma is officially recognised.

Others, especially those applying for highly competitive degrees, may need to take the official PAU/PCE university entrance exams.

The course ends in late May, and the PAU exam period takes place at the beginning of June. Admission support continues until July. Please note that paperwork fees and other university expenses are not included.

✅ What the course includes

- 20 weekly lessons of Spanish language training or academic subjects with the duration of each component adapted to the student's Spanish level.
- Personalised tutoring and academic support.
- Full guidance throughout the university admission process (Paperwork costs and other university expenses are not included).

📅 Levels

Students may join the language training as complete beginners. However, a minimum B2 level is required to begin the academic preparation phase (as requested by the Common European Framework of Reference for languages).

📄 Enrolment

To enrol/start on the course we need the following documentation:

1. **Completed enrolment form.**
2. **Photocopy** of your valid passport or NIE (I.D. letter for foreigners).
3. **Official academic certificates**, which show the subjects and corresponding grades, from upper secondary studies or at an equivalent level, certified by the school where you completed your studies or by the Spanish Consulate.
4. **Documentation should be correctly translated by:**
 - by a sworn translator in Spain, or
 - by a professional translator in your country, whose translation must then be additionally certified by the Spanish Consulate.

Important

All the documentation must be apostilled in student's original country and then translated.
